

BEACONETTE GUIDELINES - 2020

Membership Any Beacon Ridge Country Club member who establishes a handicap (by scoring five (5) scores for nine holes of completed play, front or back) on the golf course is eligible to play in Beaconette tournaments and/or games. As of 2019, club membership is no longer required, but league dues and annual handicap fee must still be paid in order to qualify for prizes.

Handicap Maximum handicap allowed for Nine (9) holes is 30. As of 2020, the new World Handicap System will only issue 18 Hole Indexes. However, these indexes are still valid for the purpose of calculating a 9 Hole Course Handicap. One-half of an 18 Hole Handicap should be used when calculating a 9 Hole Handicap.

Sign up In 2019, we started using the CGA's "Golf Genius" sign-up software. Ask the Pro Shop to put your email on the list and you'll receive a weekly email invite. There's also a sign-up sheet on the Beaconettes bulletin board in the locker room.

Cancel Call Pro Shop by 7:30 am on Thursday, day of play - 673-2950

Arrive Twenty (20) minutes before tee time

Know Game of the Day will be posted on the sign-up sheet and will be listed in your e-vite. A printed sheet of the game schedule is usually handed out at the General Membership meeting at the beginning of each season. We also post a copy of the schedule on the bulletin board.

Score Cards Must be signed, attested and dated on day of play and turned in immediately to the Pro Shop.

Post Score Adjusted score must be posted on the same day of play. "Adjusted" means that you can post only a maximum number of strokes for any one hole. If your handicap changes, your 'maximum' may change also. (The new CGA/GHIN posting software will track this information.) The Pro will post our scores for us on league play days. We must post our own scores any other time we play, home or away. There's an I-Pad in the Pro Shop for this purpose. We can also download the GHIN posting software to our computers, phones, or tablet devices.

Weekly Prizes Weekly prize money will be given in the form of cash distributed at the annual awards luncheon in December.

Awards Sheet There is a **Birdie and Chip In** sheet posted on the bulletin board in the locker room. After each round of league play, when a birdie and/or a chip in has been achieved by a player, the player must sign and date the sheet and record the hole on which it was achieved. Credit will be received at the December awards luncheon for each: birdies \$2.00 & chip-ins \$2.00.

Beaconette Cup This is a flighted, low-net tournament played on the first Thursday of every month. The player with the lowest net score of the entire field is the monthly winner of the cup. You can only win the cup once during a season, so if the first lowest net has already won a previous cup, then the second lowest net takes the cup. The prize is a golf towel with an embroidered Beaconettes logo.

Beaconette Championship Any Beaconette who has played a minimum of five (5) weekly games can qualify to play in the Championship Tournament. There are three low net scores in the Championship. The first score is the lowest net of each player from all rounds played so far that season. This gives everyone the chance to better their low net score through the season to start the tournament. The next two scores are the net scores from rounds 1 and 2 of the Championship Tournament, played on two consecutive Thursdays. The player who has the best two out of three low net scores is our Champion.
